BARE ROOT ONLY with PLANT TAGS

To avoid the spread of the invasive Jumping Worm, our Plant Swap and Sale is BARE ROOT ONLY (bring plants in gallon size zip type bags with a little water in the bottom, not in soil). Read about this invasive and destructive pest on the Friends website.

Plants should have descriptive tags. Visit the Friends website to download a sheet of labels or pick up labels and a plant prep tip sheet after May 15th on the Friends chest of drawers in the lobby of the Library.)

Drop Off in the Library's Board Room
Friday, June 5 between 1:30 and 5:00PM
or on the day of sale under the Library portico, beginning at 9:30AM and no later than 11:00 AM

This year, anyone donating plants will be given a coupon worth \$1 for each plant donated (up \$5) to use toward swapping. Donors will be allowed in to swap at 9:45am.

BUY PLANTS

At 10 AM until noon, any plants not taken in swap will be available for purchase. We keep the prices very low (50 cents to three dollars depending on size and rarity of the plant, with a few really special plants slightly higher).
